PRACTICE: The track will be available for unofficial practice on Thursday 23-9-03 and Friday 24-9-03 from 11am to 4.30pm. A practice fee of \$10 will be levied on Friday.

SHOP: Will be open on Friday (limited selection), Saturday and Sunday.

PRIZE GIVINGS for **Lascom Sprints** and **UHCGP** will take place at the completion of Tech on the Sunday.

Practices, qualifying and Heat Q1 for **Junior Development** and **Max Challenge** will be included in the Saturday race programme.

FORMAT: Lascom Sprints: clockwise. Rule 19 format applies to all classes. Oversubscribed: see Rule 19.10.

Upper Hutt City Grand Prix: clockwise. CIK style format applies as modified below except Junior Development and Max Challenge, where the series regulations apply.

All other classes will receive two predetermined grid position heats with heat one grid drawn from the hat, heat two grid the reverse of heat one grid. Points as per KartSport New Zealand format. An oversubscribed two heat system will be used where a field is oversubscribed (ie each competitor will contest two pre-determined grid heats). DQ as per Rule 20.7.DNS as per Rule 20.5.

The pre-final grid will be established as follows:

Up to 24 in field: Grid based on low points from heats to the front, ties as per Rule 19.6 and failing this by the toss of a coin.

More than 24 in field: The 20 lowest points competitors from the pre-determined heats gridded lowest to the front, ties as per Rule 19.6 and failing this by the toss of a coin. The next 24 lowest points competitors will then contest a Last Chance Heat to determine the last eight pre-final grid positions.

Competitors must start pre-final to be eligible to start final. Final grid will be as per pre-final finishing order. Finishing order in final determines result. Race lengths in the ratio – heats 10 laps: pre-final 20 laps: final 30 laps with a minimum 15 minute final for senior classes.

PRIZEGIVING: Separate sets of trophies will be awarded for each day's racing. Presentations in the club house following teching on Sunday 3rd October.

ENTRY FORMS: A separate, fully completed entry form and entry fee is required for each day of racing, except that Junior Development and Max Challenge have one race fee and two ambulance fees.

TECH INSPECTION: Each day is a separate event so engine tech maybe carried out on both days.

SPONSOR'S SIGNAGE: Competitors in the **Upper Hutt City Grand Prix** may be required to attach a self adhesive helmet visor strip to their helmet visor. Strips will need to be attached as at scrutineering each day and remain on the visor for the duration of racing.

Competitors in the **Lascom Sprints** may be required to attach a self adhesive nose cone sticker.

Ratings will not be valid unless they are dated at least 10 days prior to the event at which they are produced.

A Rotax Max will be recognised as Heavy if meeting the Heavy weight requirement at all weighins, but does not race separately.

MEMBERSHIP: Proof of current financial membership of a KartSport New Zealand affiliated club must be presented at scrutineering, together with a current KartSport New Zealand licence. A scrutineered licence book must be presented at confirmation of entry on each race day.
